"Track your performance" consists of three parts; Visibility, leads and attendance. Here you get insight into numbers and the possibility to download your leads.

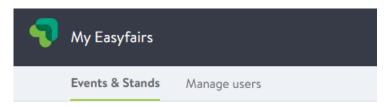

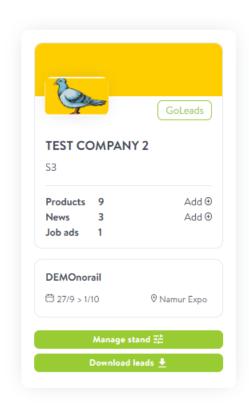

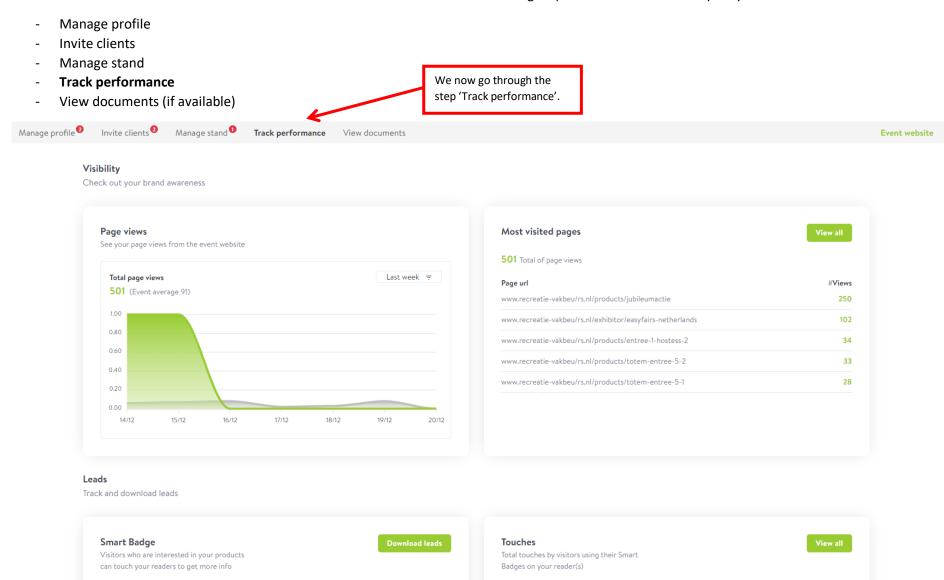
When you're logged in to My Easyfairs, click on "Manage stand".

Step 1: Visibility

Under visibility you will see the number of page views of your pages on the exhibition website. You can filter by last week, last month or last year. You can also see the average page views of all exhibitors participating in the event. Your most visited pages are shown on the right side.

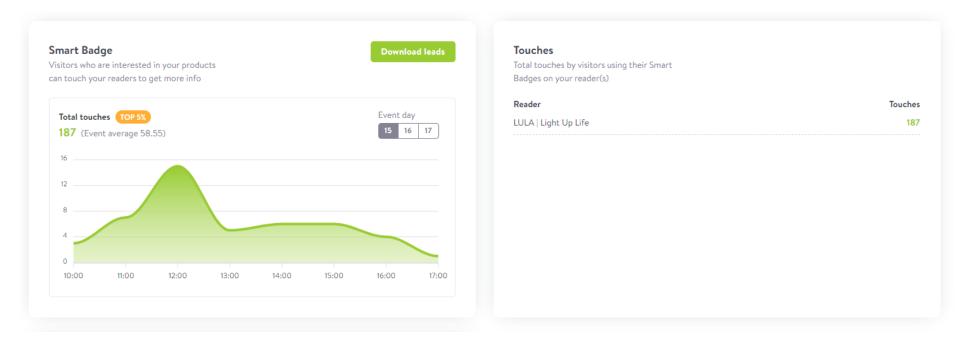

Step 2: Leads

The 'Leads' section consists of 2 sub-sections; Smart Badge and Visit Connect.

Smart badge

During the event, visitors could easily scan your Smart Badge reader with their Smart Badge. Even if you have not been able to speak to them personally. Take the time now to contact these leads. The graph shows per event day how often your Smart Badge reader has been scanned and at what times. If you click on 'Download Leads', an GDPR notification will appear, after which you click on 'Download Leads' again and you can save the Excel file with all data for further follow-up.

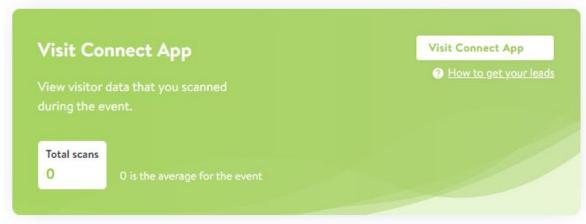


Visit Connect

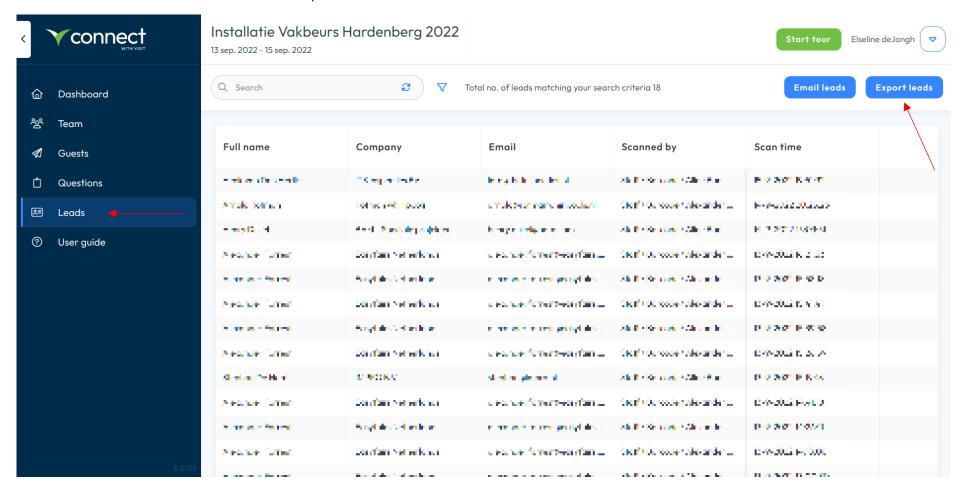
You use Visit Connect as a registration tool for the conversations you have during the exhibition. Where the initiative lies with the visitor with the Smart Badge, you as an exhibitor have control over the use of Visit Connect. You ask the visitor for permission to scan his Smart Badge with the Visit Connect tool after you have had a face-to-face conversation with this visitor. You use the tool as a digital business card with which you immediately receive the details of

the contact you have spoken to and can also add important notes. This way you qualify your leads in a very simple way and it becomes easy to follow up on this.

Click on 'Visit Connect App' to go to the Visit Connect portal.



Go to the Leads tab in Visit Connect to see and export the leads.



Step 3: Attendance

Under 'Attendance' you can see how many potential visitors have registered via an invitation of you and how many of these registered visitors have actually visited the event. You will also see the average figures of all exhibitors together.
